images (photographs), and/or full motion video clips, as well as audio narration to convey the required learning objectives as defined in the government furnished storyboards.

Graphics, animated graphics, and/or video are required for each storyboard. Training Systems Implementation Team (TSIT) will provide all required digital graphics and full motion digital video. Any video used in producing ICW shall be in MPEG format, or other format compatible with the Windows Media Player 6.4 or in accordance with the current version of the Submarine Onboard Training (SOBT) Interactive Courseware (ICW) Developer's Guide. - 1.1. The VIRGINIA Class Program Office (PMS450F) has a requirement for training products that will allow VIRGNIA Class sailors to meet Type Commander mission requirements for new systems.
- 2.0 Scope
- 2.1. This effort is for training services and consists of producing interactive courseware (ICW) from government provided storyboards in support of training for the VIRGINIA Class Submarine. Throughout this solicitation, ICW and Interactive Multimedia Instruction (IMI) are considered synonymous.
- 3.0. Specific Task

- 5.6.1. The Contractor can use any authoring system that uses HTML for display of the product and facilitates changes, revisions, interoperability with Logistics Technical Data (LTD) products, and life-cycle support using common commercially available development tools.
